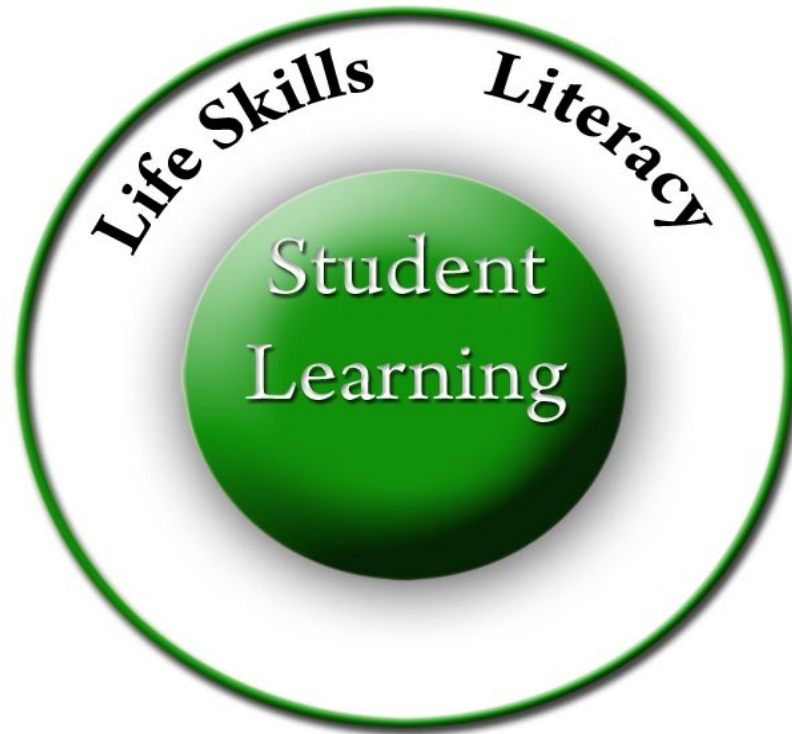

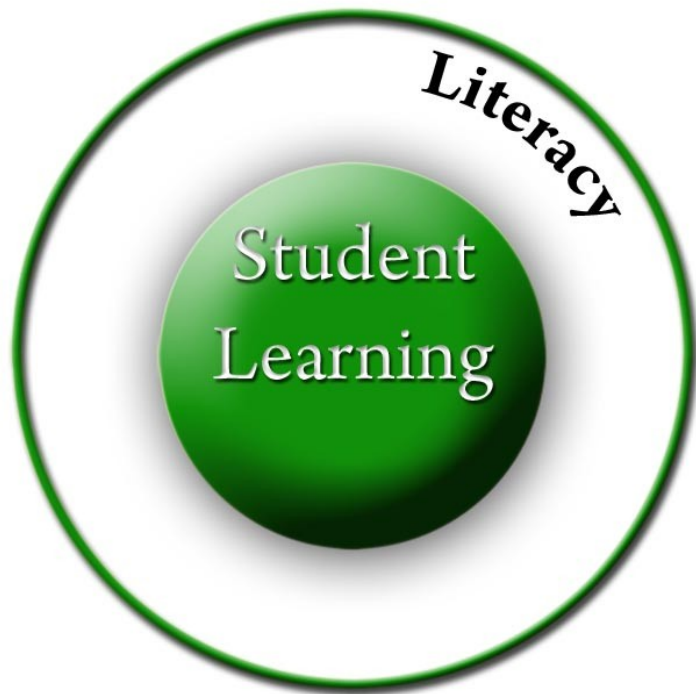


- Demonstrating respect for people and the environment

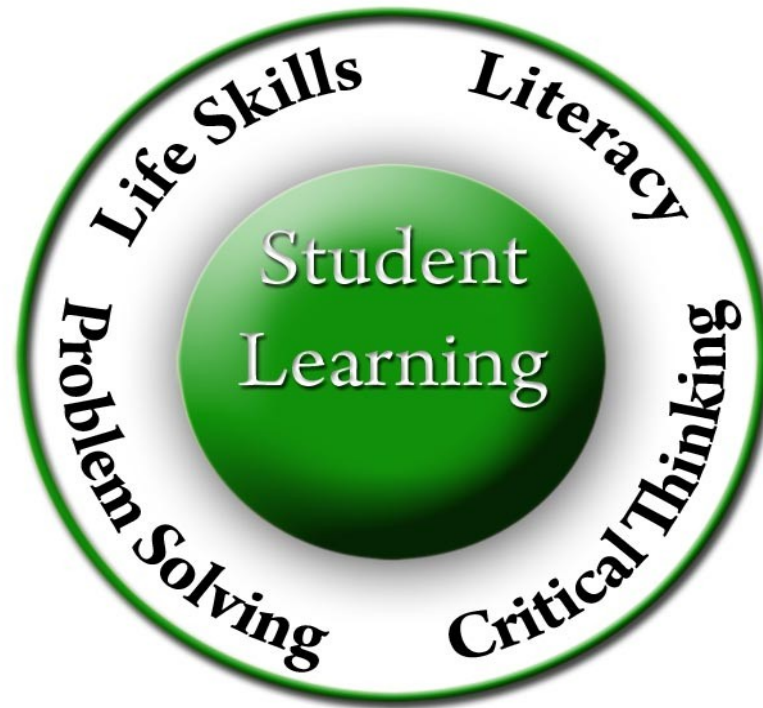


Problem Solving

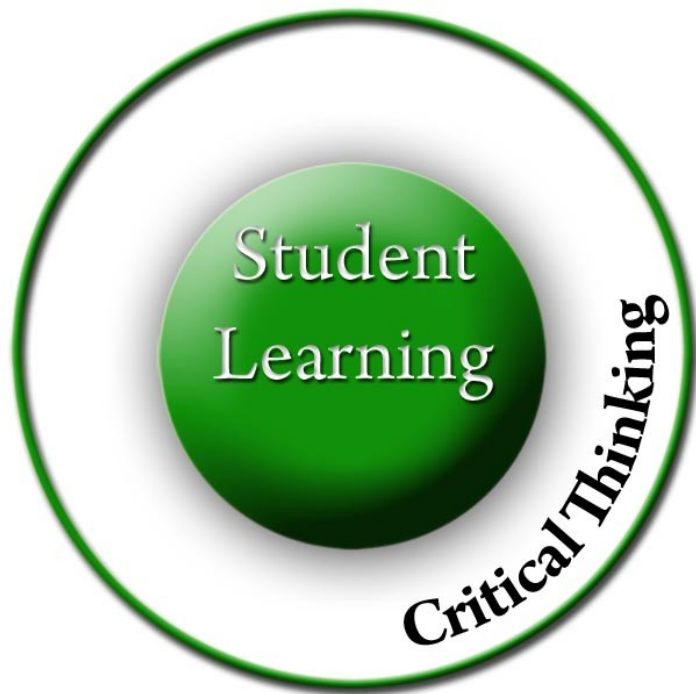


- Knowledge and skills to solve problems and make decisions

- Framing, analyzing and synthesizing information in order to solve problems and answer questions

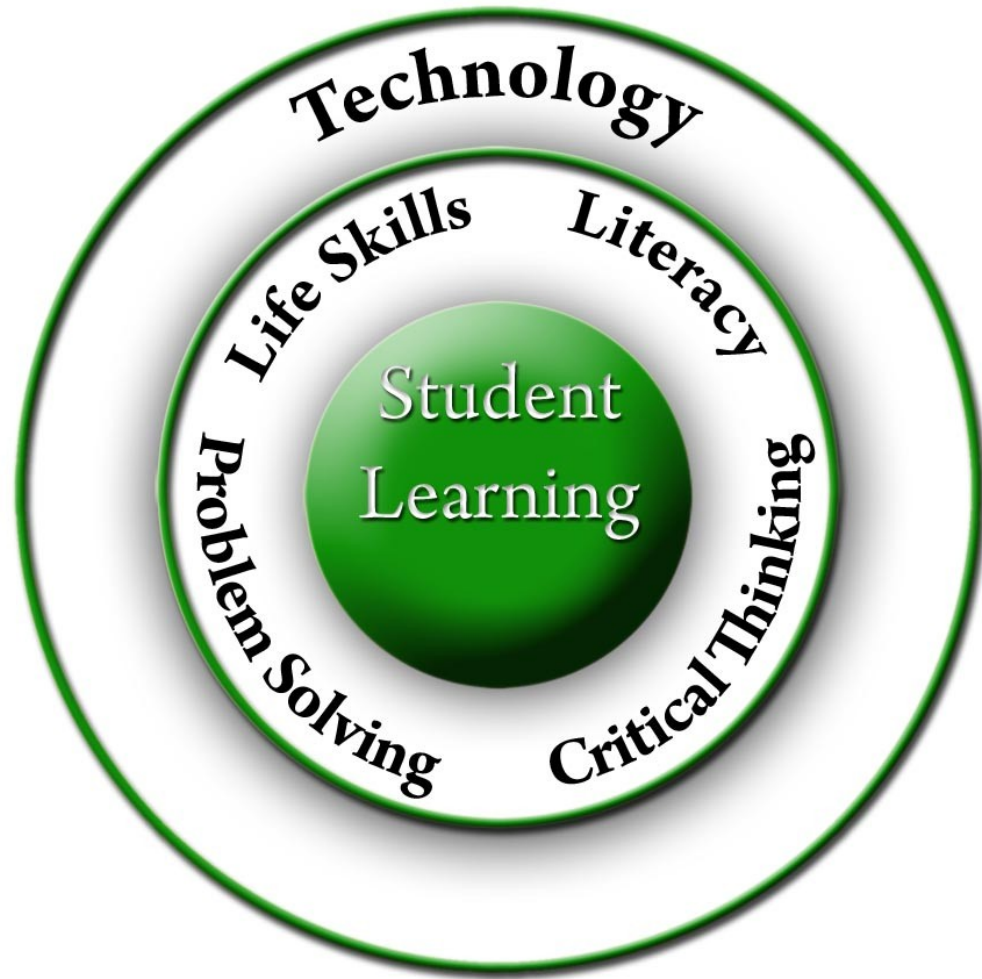

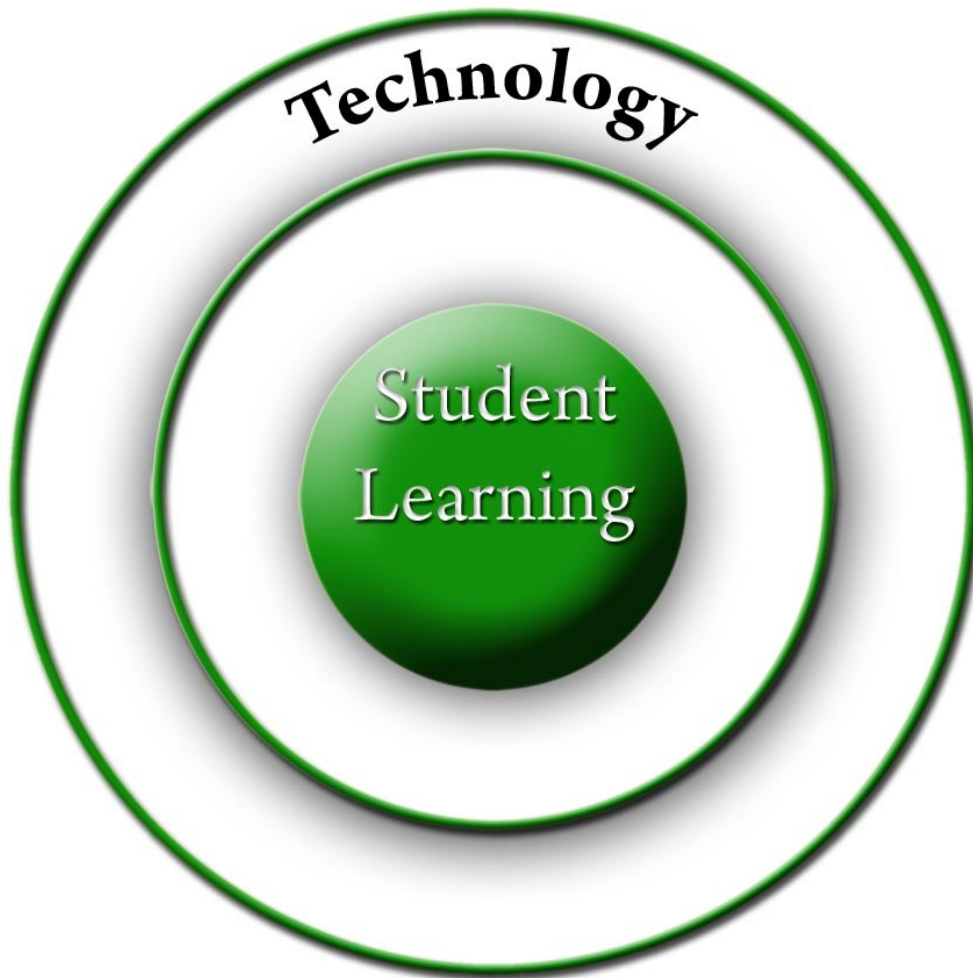
Critical Thinking



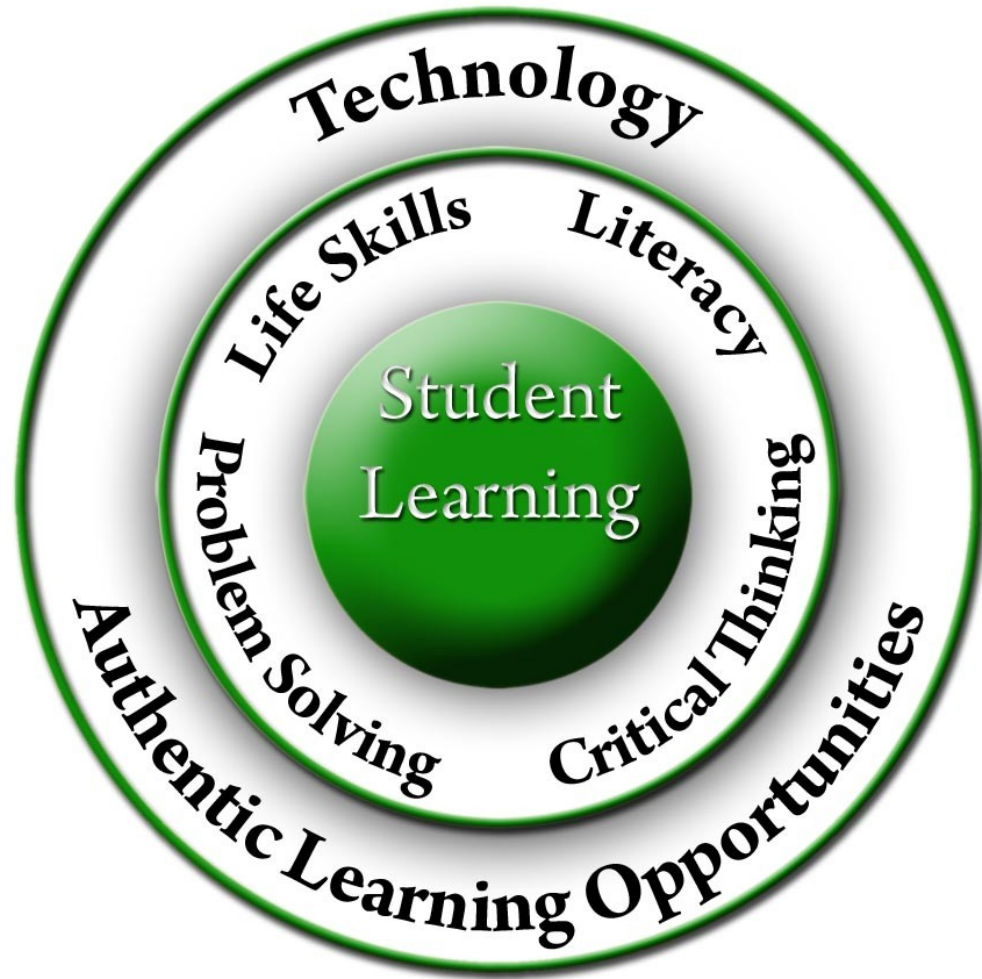
- Demonstrating skills to understand, comprehend, apply, analyze and evaluate information

Technology



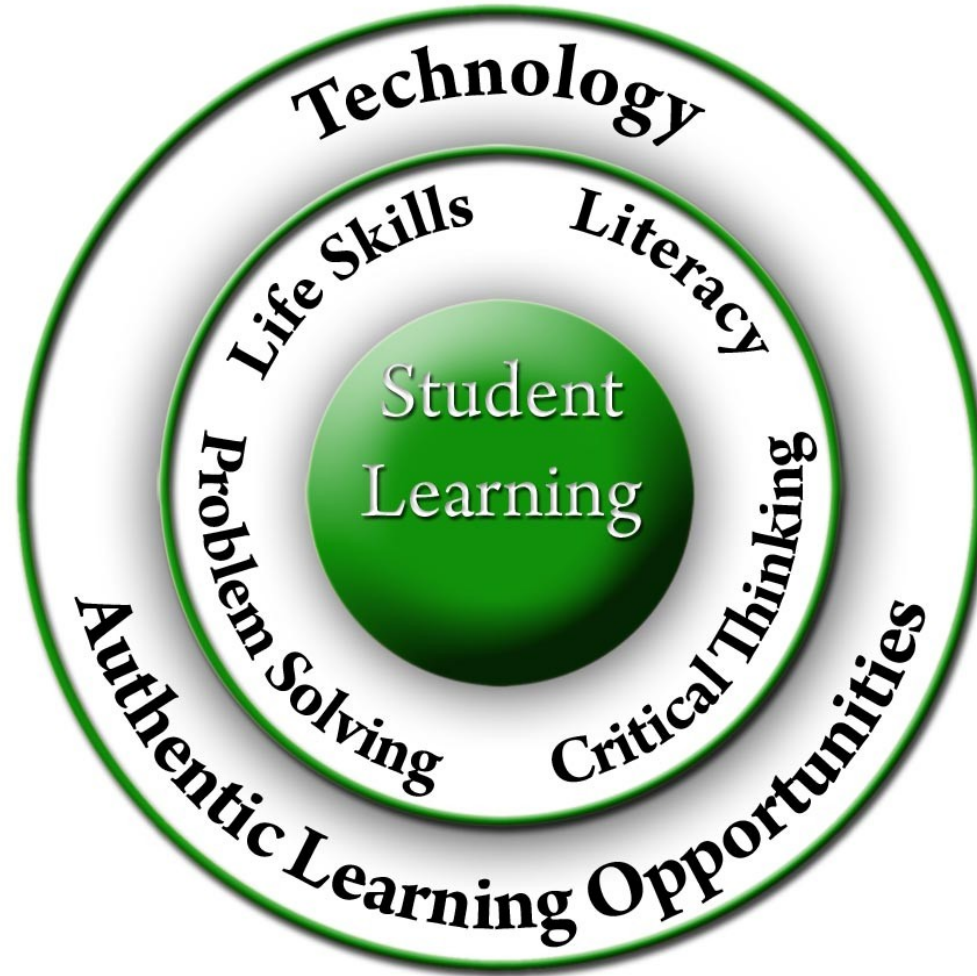
- Using technology as a tool to research, organize, evaluate and communicate information
